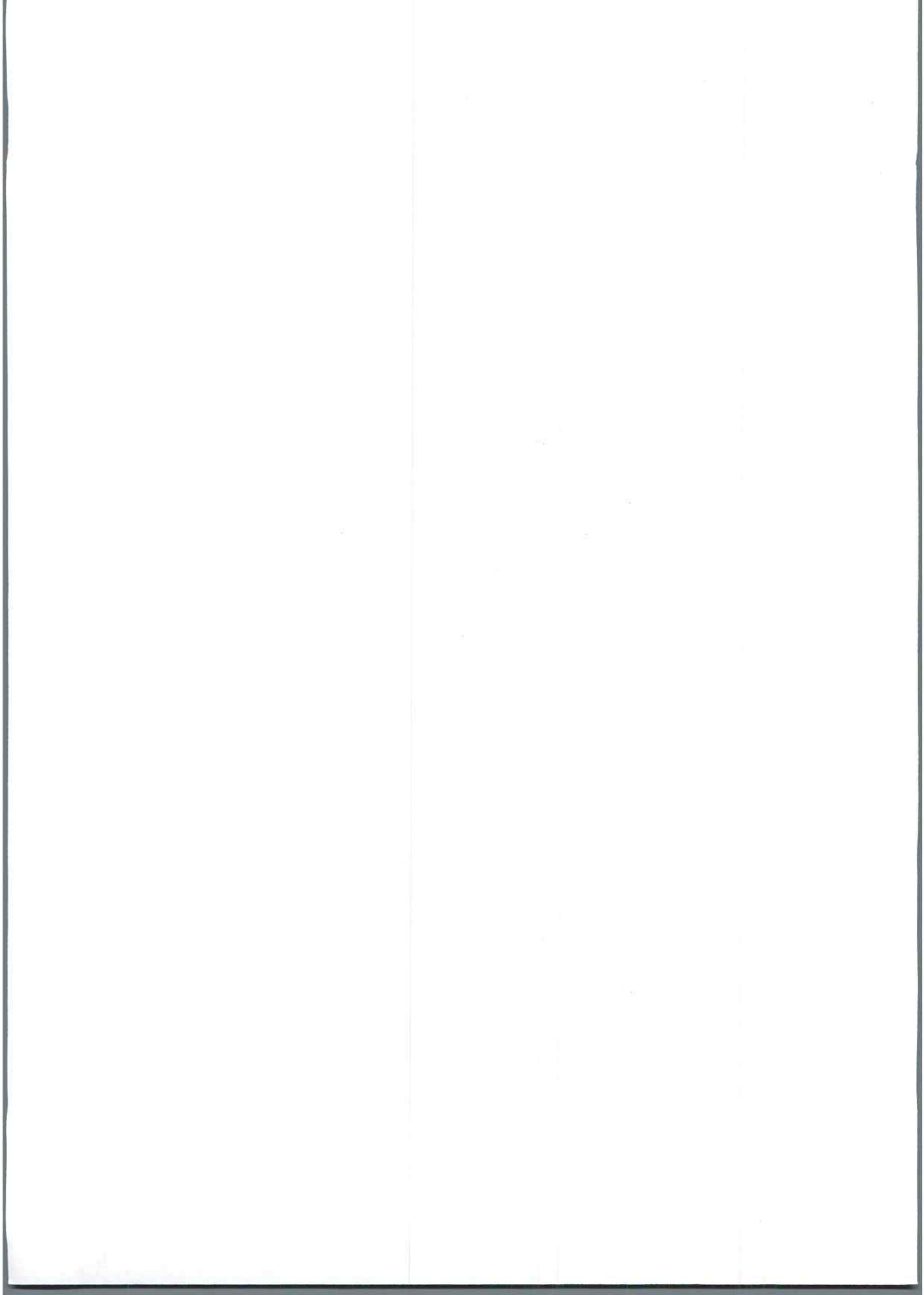

This was a trip I'll never forget. I was little, my parents and I decided to spend our weekend camping.

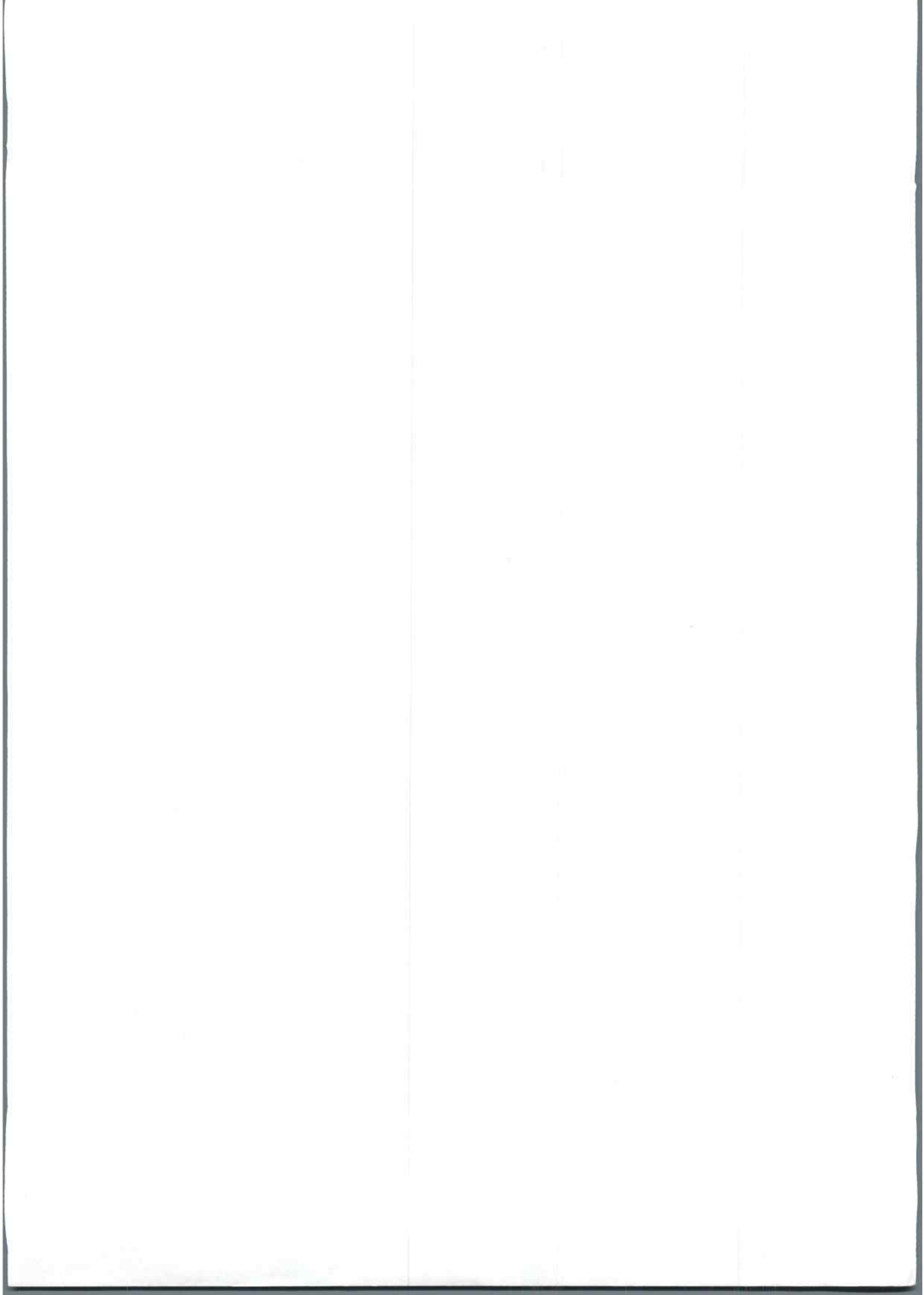
