smile on my face, not tears.

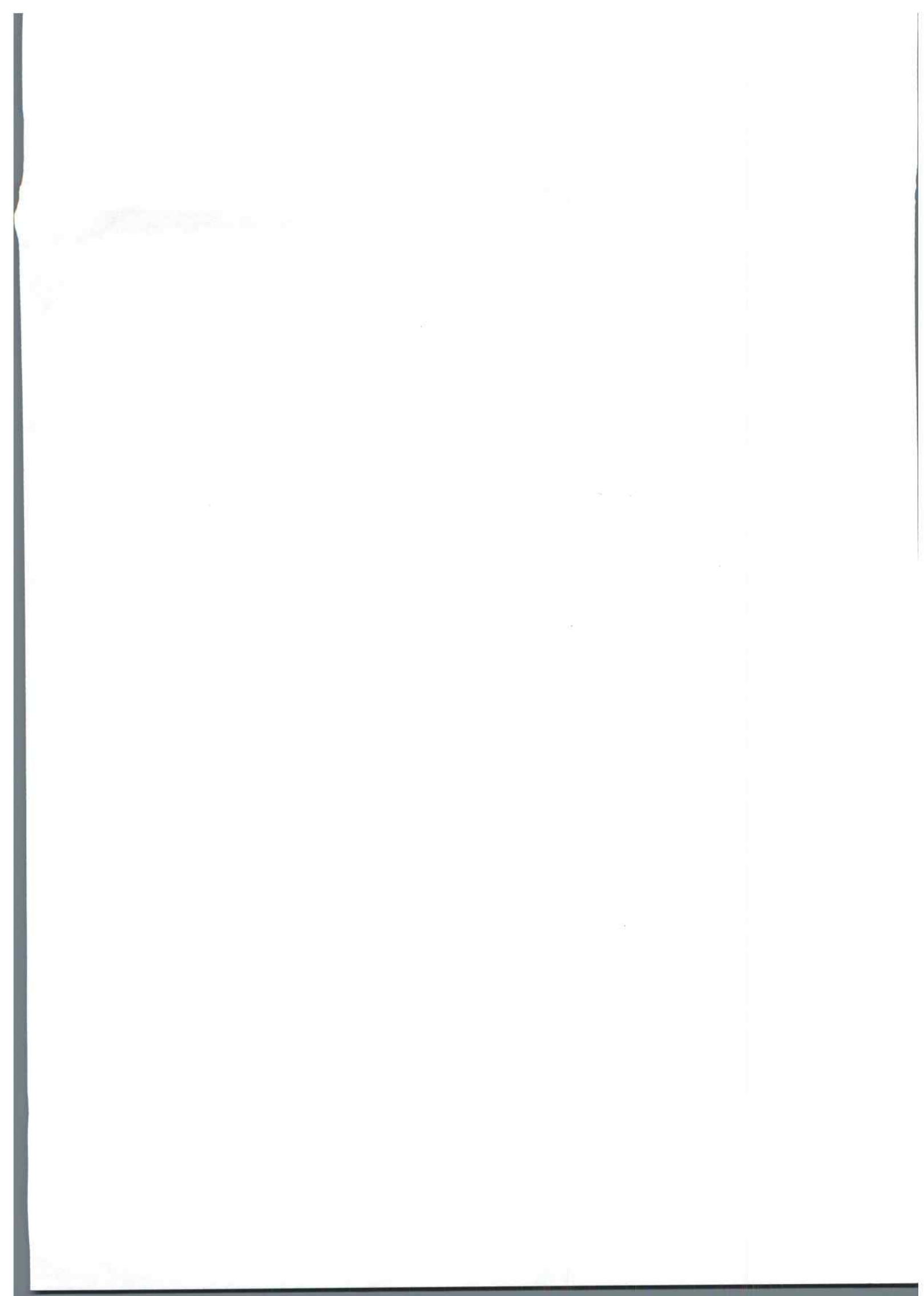
