## The Attendance of Museums and Galleries.

### Summary

The number of people attending English museums and galleries is variable. People's attendance of British Museum, National Gallery and Tate Gallery has been respectively growing since 2013. Nevertheless, Natural History Museum and Science Museum had much more visitors in 2013 than in 2015 and 2017.

### Comparison

In 2017 British Museum was attended by 5.6 million people which is approximately two times more than in 2013. To compare with, the number of visitors of the Natural History Museum has decreased from 3.7 million people to 1.9 million. 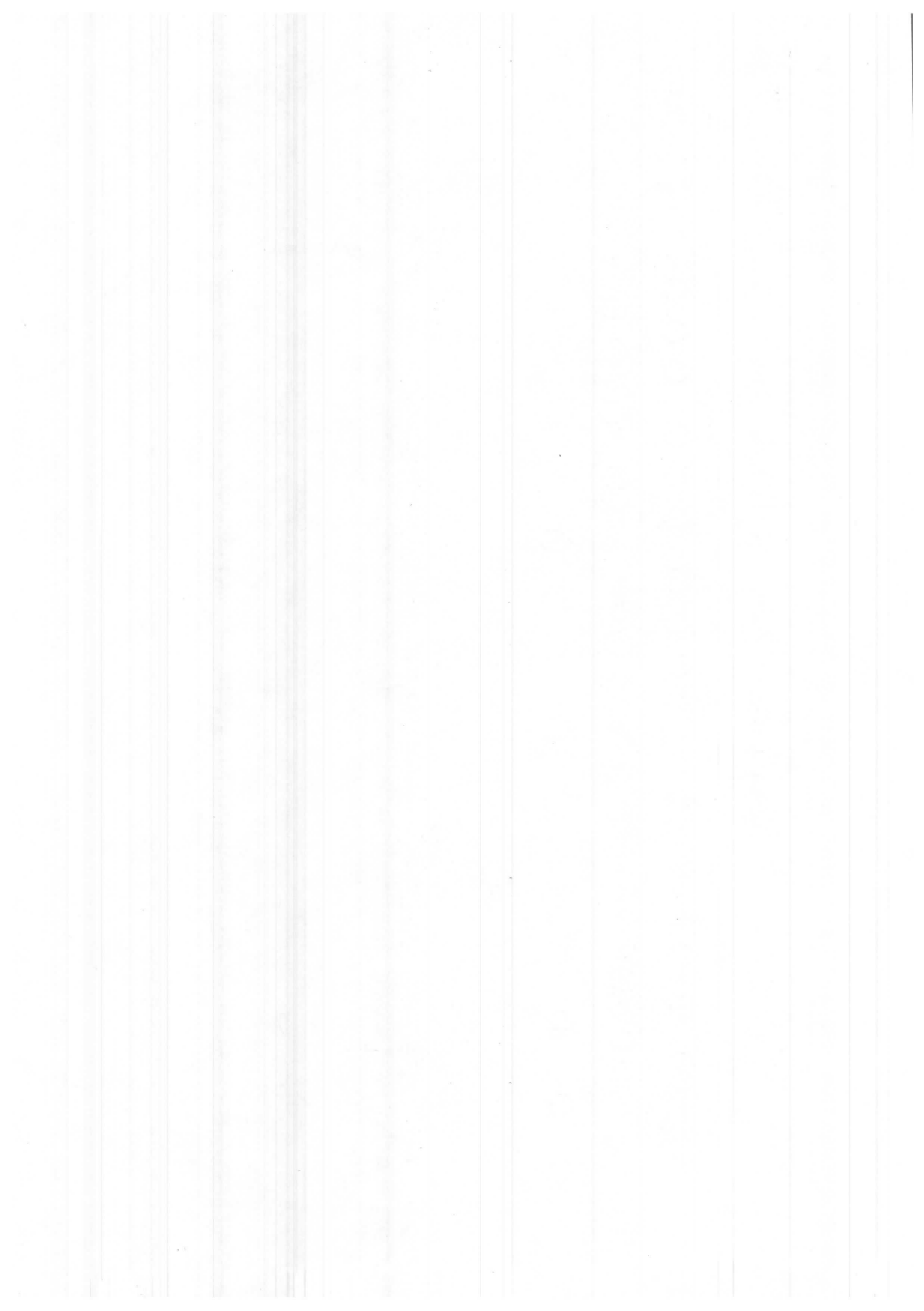
