## National museums' visits' analysis.

Having the table studied, two of the main tendencies are respectively clear. British museum had doubled its ~~number~~ number of visitors since 2013. National and Tate galleries started to appeal more to the society with a substantial increase in its attendance rate. Some museums such as Natural History Museum and Science museum had suffered a great attendance loss. Everything to be claimed above has happened due to the introduction of the admission charge in 2014.

Tate Gallery has never been well-attended before admission charge took place. Back in 2013 National History and Science museums ~~were~~ had from 3 to 4 times more visitors than Tate Gallery. In 2017 each of them can barely catch on with Tate Gallery. British Museum and National Gallery had become more popular since then, yet British Museum became the leader in this "race".

I would strongly recommend drawing attention on the question of making entrance fee cheaper. In addition, I would recommend organising cross-over exhibitions between museums.

All-in-all, this change was to be expected. Admission charges made some museums more popular, while making others less popular.
